TULSA, Okla. – Baylor men's tennis will take its annual fall trip to Oklahoma for the 2024 ITA All-American Championships at the Case Tennis Center. Play opens Saturday morning with the pre-qualifying draw and runs through Sunday, Sept. 29, when All-American Champions will be crowned in singles and doubles.

Qualifications for pre-qualifying, qualifying and main draws were announced in _____ by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association. Selections are made automatically by the national preseason rankings and each player's universal tennis rating.

Four Bears will play in the pre-qualifying stages. Luc Koenig, Louis Bowden, Oskar Brostrom Poulsen and Marko Miladinovic will hit the courts in the round of 256 to contend for a spot in the qualifying bracket.

After two days of pre-qualifying, the top 16 players will play in the qualifying draw that begins Monday, Sept. 23.

Both Devin Badenhorst and Zsombor Velcz will start in the 128-player qualifying draw.

Following two more days of competition, the 16 remaining competitors from qualifiers play in the main draw starting Wednesday, Sept. 25.

In doubles, Brostrom Poulsen and Miladinovic will play in the main draw. The pair earned their spot by conquering the doubles ITA Summer Championships, 6-4, 6-2.

Badenhorst and Velcz will play through the doubles qualifying draw, and Koenig and Bowden will play through doubles prequalifying matches.

Cracked Rackets will provide a commentated live stream of the matches once main draw play begins on Sept. 25. The streams are available on the [Intercollegiate Tennis Association YouTube page](#).
